Since 2011, IMPULS—a venture from Tokyo Gakugei University—has been sharing the value of Lesson Study in Japan with educators around the world. In this interactive session, participants will experience a mock TTP lesson using materials developed by Japanese teachers through Lesson Study. Working together, we will explore how to design engaging, student-centered lessons that spark curiosity and foster deep thinking.

The sample materials focus on elementary mathematics with an emphasis on computational thinking but educators of all subjects, grade levels, and school types are warmly welcome. Bilingual worksheets (English and Japanese) will be provided to support future lesson planning. Although the workshop takes place during a limited afterschool time slot, it offers a rich opportunity for practical learning and international exchange.
